


Te Ara Oranga

Reduce methamphetamine demand by enhancing treatment services and increasing our responsiveness. Northland DHB, NZ Police together with community agencies lead Te Ara Oranga, the Methamphetamine Harm Reduction initiative in Northland that launched in October 2017. Te Ara Oranga is about working in a tangible and engaging style with the community and agencies, focusing on delivering a holistic approach to health and policing to produce better outcomes for all. The initiative links evidence-based health services with police prevention and enforcement activity.




Te Whatu Ora **Health New Zealand**

The Ministry of Health 'Amphetamine Use 2018/19: New Zealand Health Survey' reports 1 percent (equates to about 39,000 New Zealanders) of adults used amphetamines in the past year, with Māori 1.29 times more likely to have used amphetamine than non-Māori.
